Tonight's Match

Chicago plays its first-ever game under the lights and on FieldTurf at the newly-renovated Stagg Field ... The Maroons enter the match having won two straight and four of their last five affairs ... Chicago is 2-1 at home this season ... In their most recent outing, the Maroons blanked Aurora 2-0 Saturday at Stagg Field ... Beloit is coming off a 2-1 loss to Midwest Conference rival Grinnell this past Saturday.

Chicago vs. Beloit

The Maroons and Buccannners clash for the 27th time dating back to 1976 ... Chicago holds a 17-9 series advantage ... The Maroons defeated Beloit 2-0 on the road a year ago ... In the most recent matchup at Stagg Field in 2005, Chicago routed the Bucs 7-1.

Maroons at Home

Chicago has won two of three home games this year ... Under second-year Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**, the Maroons are 7-2-2 overall and 6-1-1 in non-conference games at Stagg Field ... After playing eight home games without a point a year ago, sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux (Madison, Wis./ West)** has collected all five of his points this season (2 goals, 1 assist) at home ... Friloux tallied twice this past Saturday as the Maroons defeated Aurora 2-0.

Friloux Nets a Pair

Sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux's (Madison, Wis./ West)** two goals Saturday against Aurora marked the second multiple-goal effort of his career and the first by a Chicago player in 2007 ... Friloux found the net twice against Wis.-Whitewater on Oct. 21, 2006.

Second Half Surge

After failing to score a second-half goal in eight consecutive matches – including the first six in 2007 – Chicago has tallied three times in the second period in its last two games.

Marshall in the Box Score

Sophomore defender **Andrew Marshall (Rockford, Ill./ Boylan)** recorded his first career point when he assisted on sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux's (Madison, Wis./ West)** game-winner in the 58th minute this past Saturday against Aurora.

Clifford Tops the List

Freshman forward **Alex Clifford (Houston, Texas/ Phillips Andover Academy)** collected his team-leading third assist of the year in Saturday's win over Aurora ... He enters today's game as the Maroons' scoring leader with seven points (2 goals, 3 assists).

Baron Between the Posts

Freshman goalkeeper **Steven Baron (Chalfont, Pa./ Penn Charter)** has started the Maroons' last five matches and is 4-1 in those contests with a pair of shutouts ... In 450 minutes of action, Baron has posted a 0.80 goals against average with one shutout.
