Notes & Numbers

Today's Match

Chicago returns to UAA play against fifth-ranked Case ... The Maroons make their first appearance at Stagg Field in 23 days ... Chicago remains mathematically alive in the UAA race, but would be eliminated with a loss or tie ... Case begins the day tied for fourth place in the league standings needing a tie or win to remain in the hunt for the UAA title ... Chicago looks to snap a two-game losing streak ... The Spartans are unbeaten (2-0-1) in their last three outings.

Chicago vs. Case

The Maroons and Spartans meet for the 22nd time since 1986 ... Chicago holds a 12-8-1 series advantage ... Case won 2-1 last year in Cleveland to end a seven-game series losing streak ... The Maroons are 5-0-1 against the Spartans at Stagg Field since 1995 ... In the last meeting in Chicago in 2005, the Maroons prevailed 2-0.

Maroons at Stagg Field

Chicago is 2-3 overall and 0-1 in UAA play at Stagg Field ... The Maroons have dropped their last two home matches, including a 3-0 loss to Wisconsin-Whitewater in their most recent appearance at Stagg Field on Oct. 3 ... In their only previous UAA match in Chicago, the Maroons fell to Emory 3-2 in double overtime back on Sept. 29 ... In two years under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**, Chicago is 7-4-2 on its home field.

Chicago vs. the Top 25

Today's match marks the Maroons' third against a team ranked in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America top-25 poll at game time ... Earlier this year, the Maroons lost to then #18 Emory 3-2 in double overtime (Sept. 29) and fell to then #19 NYU 3-2 on Oct. 14 ... Chicago entertains Rochester - which currently shares the #5 national ranking with Case - Sunday at noon.

Clifford Leading the UAA

Through the first four games of the seven-game UAA slate, no player has tallied more goals than freshman forward **Alex Clifford (Houston, Texas/ Phillips Academy Andover)** ... Clifford has notched four goals in league play ... He scored twice against Emory (Sept. 29) before finding the net against Carnegie Mellon (Oct. 6) and Brandeis (Oct. 12).

Fitzgerald Second in the UAA

Freshman forward **Ryan Fitzgerald's (Beaverton, Ore./ Westview)** two assists in UAA action place him a four-way tie for second in the league in that category ... He assisted on the goal which forced overtime in an eventual 3-2 loss to Emory (Sept. 29) before assisting on the winning tally in the Maroons' 1-0 victory at Brandeis (Oct. 12).

Corner Kicks

Chicago has been involved in two overtime affairs this season: a 3-2 double O.T. loss to Emory (Sept. 29) and a 2-2 draw at Carnegie Mellon (Oct. 6). Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski** is 0-3-2 in overtime in his two years with the Maroons ... Freshman goalkeeper **Steven Baron (Chalfont, Pa./ Penn Charter)** has logged all of the team's 391 minutes in UAA play, during which he has posted a 1.84 goals against average with one shutout ... Chicago has outscored its opponents 13-7 in the first half and has been outscored 15-6 in the second period.
