## Notes & Numbers

### Today's Match

Chicago opens University Athletic Association play this afternoon ... The Maroons have been idle since defeating Aurora 2-0 at Stagg Field this past Saturday ... Chicago was slated to host Beloit on Tuesday night, but the game was postponed because of lightning in the vicinity ... The Maroons enter today's affair having won two straight and four of their last five matches ... Emory is coming off a 3-1 win over Oglethorpe on Sunday ... Currently ranked 18th in the NCAA Division III coaches poll, Emory represents Chicago's first top-25 opponent in 2007.

### Chicago vs. Emory

The Maroons and Eagles meet for the 20th time since 1987 ... Chicago trails the all-time series 13-4-2, but is unbeaten (2-0-1) in the last three matchups ... Chicago defeated the Eagles 2-1 in Atlanta a year ago ... In the last meeting at Stagg Field in 2005, the Maroons cruised to a 4-0 victory ... Emory's last series win was a 3-1 decision in Chicago in 2003.

### Maroons at Home

Chicago sports a 2-1 mark at Stagg Field this season ... Under second-year Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**, the Maroons are 7-2-2 overall and 1-1-1 in UAA games at Stagg Field ... After playing in eight home games without registering a point a year ago, sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux (Madison, Wis./ West)** has collected all five of his points this season (2 goals, 1 assist) at home ... Friloux tallied twice last Saturday as the Maroons defeated Aurora 2-0.

### Second Half Surge

After failing to score a second-half goal in eight consecutive matches – including the first six in 2007 – Chicago has tallied three times in the second period in its last two games.

### Friloux Nets a Pair

Sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux's (Madison, Wis./ West)** two goals last week against Aurora marked the second multiple-goal effort of his career and the first by a Chicago player in 2007 ... Friloux found the net twice against Wisconsin-Whitewater on Oct. 21, 2006.

### Marshall in the Box Score

Sophomore defender **Andrew Marshall (Rockford, Ill./ Boylan)** recorded his first career point when he assisted on sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux's (Madison, Wis./ West)** game-winner in the 58th minute last Saturday against Aurora.

### Clifford Tops the List

Freshman forward **Alex Clifford (Houston, Texas/ Phillips Andover Academy)** collected his team-leading third assist of the year in Saturday's win over Aurora ... He enters today's game as the Maroons' scoring leader with seven points (2 goals, 3 assists).

### Baron Between the Posts

Freshman goalkeeper **Steven Baron (Chalfont, Pa./ Penn Charter)** has started the Maroons' last five matches and is 4-1 in those contests with a pair of shutouts ... In 450 minutes of action, Baron has posted a 0.80 goals against average with one shutout.
