Chicago opens the home portion of its 2007 slate this afternoon ... The Maroons are coming off a 2-0 loss at Dominican (Ill.) on Wednesday afternoon ... Robert Morris saw its season-opening four-game winning streak end on Wednesday when it dropped a 5-0 decision at Elmhurst.

Maroons at Stagg Field

Chicago owns a 5-1-2 mark at Stagg Field under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski** ... The Maroons are unbeaten in their last three home affairs (2-0-1) dating back to last season ... In non-conference home play under Wiercinski, Chicago stands at 4-0-1 ... In its 2006 home opener, Chicago defeated Kalamazoo 4-1.

Floyd Notches Fourth Game-Winner

Junior forward **Eric Floyd's (McMurray, Pa./ Peters)** goal in the first minute last Saturday against Webster marked his fourth career game-winning tally – most among active Maroons ... Senior forward **Andrew Hamilton (Springfield, Ill./ Sacred Heart-Griffin)** and sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux (Madison, Wis./ West)** each have three career game-winning goals to their credit.

Freshmen Find the Net

Newcomers have accounted for two of the Maroons' three goals this season ... Last Saturday against Webster, freshman midfielder **Andy Dallos (Weston, Mass./ Weston)** and fellow first-year midfielder **Ryan Fitzgerald (Beaverton, Ore./ Westview)** tallied in the sixth and 30th minutes, respectively ... Two other newcomers – forward **Alex Clifford (Houston, Texas/ Phillips Academy Andover)** and midfielder **Kenzo Manners (Japan/ Hamamatsu-Kita)** – were credited with assists.

Gruber in Goal

Junior netminder **Micah Gruber (Rockville Centre, N.Y./ South Side)** has played all 270 minutes in goal thus far in 2007. He has posted a 1.33 goals-against-average with one shut-out ... Gruber has collected 19 saves for an average of 6.3 per 90 minutes. In seven outings in 2006, Gruber averaged 3.8 saves per 90 minutes ... Gruber's career record stands at 4-3-1.

Corner Kicks

Chicago has outshot its opponents by a 46-41 margin this season ... The Maroons have not scored a second-half goal in five straight games dating back to last year ... One or both teams have been shutout in the Maroons' last six affairs dating back to the 2006 campaign.
