## Notes & Numbers

### Today's Match

Chicago looks to rebound from a 2-1 overtime loss to Case at Stagg Field Friday afternoon ... That loss, the team's third in a row, mathematically eliminated the Maroons from contention for the UAA title ... Chicago hopes to end a three-game overall losing streak and a three-game skid at Stagg Field ... This afternoon's game marks the Maroons' second Sunday match of the season, following a 3-2 loss at NYU two weeks ago ... Rochester tied Washington 1-1 on Friday night to maintain a one-point lead in the Association standings ... The Yellowjackets are the only UAA team yet to have lost in conference play.

### Chicago vs. Rochester

The Maroons and Yellowjackets meet for the 22nd time since 1983 ... Rochester leads the series 15-3-3 ... Since 1998, Rochester holds a slim 4-2-3 edge ... Last year, the teams battled to a 1-1 draw in Rochester ... The Yellowjackets won the last meeting in Chicago, a 2-1 decision in 2005 ... Three of the last four games have extended into overtime ... Chicago's last series victory was a 3-1 win in Rochester in 2001.

### Maroons at Stagg Field

Chicago is 2-4 overall and 0-2 in UAA play at Stagg Field ... The Maroons have dropped their last three home matches, including Friday's 2-1 overtime loss to fifth-ranked Case ... In two years under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**, Chicago is 7-5-2 on its home field.

### Fresh Faces

Chicago freshmen have accounted for 41% of the team's total player starts (68 of 165) ... Seven first-years started in Friday's 2-1 overtime loss to Case ... Newcomers have collected half of the Maroons' goals (10 of 20) and 74% of the total minutes in goal (1,027 of 1,387).

### Clifford Shares UAA Goals Lead

With four goals in UAA play, freshman forward **Alex Clifford (Houston, Texas/ Phillips Academy Andover)** is locked in a three-way tie for the goal-scoring lead in conference action ... Emory's **Patrick Carver** and Washington's **Nat Zenner** have also notched four goals in UAA action.

### Chicago vs. the Top 25

Today's match marks the Maroons' fourth contest against a team ranked in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America top-25 poll at game time ... Earlier this year, the Maroons lost to then #18 Emory 3-2 in double overtime (Sept. 29), then #19 NYU 3-2 (Oct. 14), and current #5 Case 2-1 in overtime on Friday ... Rochester and Case are two of three teams tied for the number five position in this week's national poll.

### Corner Kicks

Friday's 2-1 loss to Case dropped Chicago to 0-2-1 in overtime this season and to 0-4-2 in O.T. during Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski's** two-year tenure ... Freshman goalkeeper **Steven Baron (Chalfont, Pa./ Penn Charter)** has logged all of the team's 481 minutes in UAA play, during which he has posted a 1.87 goals against average with one shutout ... Chicago has outscored its opponents 14-7 in the first half and has been outscored 16-6 in the second period.
