Notes & Numbers

Today's Match

Chicago wraps up its 2007 campaign this afternoon ... The Maroons look to snap a four-game overall losing streak and three-game UAA skid ... Today's match could play a role in determining the UAA championship. Washington enters the game with 13 points in league play (4-1-1), three points behind first-place Rochester and two points behind second-place Emory.

Senior Day

This afternoon marks the final game for Chicago's four seniors: **Jon Cartwright (Franklin, Tenn./ Battle Ground Academy)**, **Mike Glass (Colorado Springs, Colo./ Cheyenne Mountain)**, **Andrew Hamilton (Springfield, Ill./ Sacred Heart-Griffin)**, and **Stuart Phelps (Helena, Mont./ Capital)**. During the past four years, the Maroons have posted a record of 42-22-9 (.637) with a pair of NCAA Division III tournament appearances.

Chicago vs. Washington

The Maroons and Bears meet for the 27th time since 1960 ... Washington holds a 20-6 series advantage ... The Bears have won three of the last four meetings, including a 1-0 decision a year ago in St. Louis ... Chicago won the last matchup at Stagg Field 1-0 in 2005 ... Chicago is 5-3 in the series since 1998.

Maroons at Stagg Field

Chicago is 2-5 overall and 0-3 in UAA play at Stagg Field ... The Maroons have dropped their last four home matches ... In two years under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**, Chicago is 7-6-2 on its home field.

Fresh Faces

Chicago freshmen have accounted for 42% of the team's total player starts (74 of 176) ... Six first-years started in the Maroons' most recent contest, a 3-1 loss to Rochester last Sunday at Stagg Field ... Newcomers have collected more than half of the Maroons' goals (11 of 21, 52%) and 76% of the total minutes in goal (1,117 of 1,477).

Back to Back

Sophomore forward **Edgar Friloux (Madison, Wis./ West)** and freshman midfielder **Kenzo Manners (Hamamatsu City, Japan/ Hamamatsu-Kita)** have notched points in consecutive games ... Friloux and Manners assisted on each others' goals in UAA play last weekend at Stagg Field ... Friloux tallied Friday against Case, before Manners scored Sunday against Rochester.

One Touches

With four goals in UAA play, freshman forward **Alex Clifford (Houston, Texas/ Phillips Academy Andover)** is locked in a three-way tie for the goal-scoring lead in conference action ... Today's match marks the Maroons' fifth contest against a team ranked in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America top-25 poll at game time. The Maroons are winless in their four previous matches against ranked opponents ... Chicago is 0-2-1 in overtime this season ... Freshman goalkeeper **Steven Baron (Chalfont, Pa./ Penn Charter)** has logged all of the team's 571 minutes in UAA play ... Chicago has outscored its opponents 15-10 in the first half and has been outscored 16-6 in the second period.
