The Maroons open the home portion of their 2008 schedule this afternoon ... Today's game marks the first of a four-game homestand ... Chicago returns to action for the first time in seven days. In their most recent affair this past Saturday, the Maroons defeated Carroll 3-2 at Wheaton's (Ill.) Bob Baptista Invitational ... Babson has also been idle since last Saturday when it defeated Colby-Sawyer 3-0 ... The Beavers are currently ranked fifth in the New England Region ... Chicago and Babson meet for the first time.

Maroons at Stagg Field

Chicago makes its 2008 home season debut this afternoon ... The Maroons are 7-6-3 at Stagg Field in three years under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**.

Wiercinski Begins Season Three

Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski** is in his third season at the helm of the Chicago men's soccer program ... Wiercinski sports a career record of 17-15-6, including a 14-8-2 mark in non-conference play.

Junior forward **Edgar Friloux (Madison, Wis./ West)** scored his fifth career game-winning goal in last week's 3-2 win over Carroll ... With a goal and an assist against Carroll, senior forward **Eric Floyd (McMurray, Pa./ Peters)** notched his fourth lifetime multiple-point effort ... Sophomore midfielder **Kenzo Manners (Hamamatsu City, Japan/ Hamamatsu-Kita)** registered his first career multiple-point performance (one goal, one assist) against Carroll ... Freshman midfielder **Stanton Coville (Powell, Ohio/ Olentangy Liberty)** scored his first career goal on a penalty kick in the Maroons' season opener against Messiah last Friday.

Between the Posts

Freshman **Chris Giusto (Davie, Fla./ Heritage)** and sophomore **Steven Baron (Chalfont, Pa./ Penn Charter)** have each started one match ... Giusto has notched a 2.67 goals against average and a 1-0 record in 135 minutes ... Baron owns an 0-1 record with a 6.00 goals against average in 45 minutes of action ... Giusto has collected 18 saves in his first two matches.

Corner Kicks

Chicago is 2-0 in home openers under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**. The Maroons edged Robert Morris-Lake County 2-1 in 2007 and defeated Kalamazoo 4-1 in 2006 ... The Maroons have scored two goals in each half.
