Today's Match

Today's game marks the final installment of a three-match homestand during which the Maroons are 1-0-1 ... Chicago was slated to host Illinois Wesleyan this past Saturday, but heavy rains forced postponement of the match until Sept. 30 ... The Maroons are 8-6-4 at Stagg Field (7-6-3 grass, 1-0-1 FieldTurf) in three years under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski** ... Dating back to last season, the Maroons are 1-0-2 in their last three home affairs ... After winning its first two matches by a 12-0 margin, Dominican has dropped back-to-back 1-0 decisions ... The Chicago/Dominican series is tied at 2-2-1 since the first meeting in 2002. The Stars defeated the Maroons 2-0 last year in west suburban River Forest.

Most Recent Match – Chicago 1, Wabash 1

Junior forward **Edgar Friloux (Madison, Wis./ West)** scored the Maroons' only goal early in the second half as Chicago battled Wabash to a 1-1 double-overtime tie last Sunday (Sept. 7) at Stagg Field ... Friloux received a long pass from sophomore midfielder **Andy Dallos (Weston, Mass./ Weston)** and tallied 7:50 into the second half to even the score at 1-1 ... Wabash opened the scoring at the 41:30 mark ... Freshman netminder **Chris Giusto (Davie, Fla./ Heritage)** stopped eight shots for the Maroons (2-1-1). Two of his saves came in overtime.

Player Notes

Junior forward **Edgar Friloux's (Madison, Wis./ West)** two goals this year have included a game-winner (vs. Carroll, Aug. 30) and a game-tying tally (vs. Wabash, Sept. 7) ... Freshman defender **Rashad Masri (Louisville, Ky./ Collegiate)** is the only freshman to have started all four matches to date ... Freshman midfielder **Stanton Coville (Powell, Ohio/ Olentangy Liberty)** owns the team's lone multiple-goal performance of the year. Coville tallied twice in a 3-2 win over Babson a week ago, giving him a team-high three goals on the season.

Between the Posts

Freshman netminder **Chris Giusto (Davie, Fla./ Heritage)** has started the Maroons' last three matches and is 2-0-1 in those contests ... Giusto sports a 1.55 goals against average as a starter ... He has collected 26 saves in his three starts.

Corner Kicks

The Maroons need just one more second half goal to match their total from all of last season. Chicago has tallied five times in the second half in four matches this year, compared to six goals in 18 games in 2007 ... The Maroons are 0-2-6 in overtime during Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski's** three-year tenure. Chicago's last overtime victory was a 3-2 win over St. John's (Minn.) in the opening round of the 2005 NCAA Division III tournament.
