Today's Match

► Chicago looks to raise its record above the .500 mark for the second time this year.

► Chicago snapped a three-game winless streak Wednesday afternoon with a 2-1 overtime victory at 16th-ranked Elmhurst. Lake Forest suffered its third straight setback yesterday in a 2-1 loss at Lawrence.

► The Maroons are 1-1-1 at Stagg Field this season. All of those matches, including a 1-0 loss to Dominican in Chicago's last home game on Sept. 16, were played on the turf field.

► In a series that dates back to 1961, Lake Forest holds a 13-6-2 advantage. Chicago defeated the Foresters 2-0 last year in Lake Forest.

Most Recent Match – Chicago 2, #16 Elmhurst 1 (ot)

► Junior midfielder **Joseph Farias-Eisner (Calabasas, Calif./ Harvard-Westlake)** scored in the seventh minute of overtime to give Chicago a 2-1 win over 16th-ranked and previously undefeated Elmhurst Wednesday afternoon.

► Chicago took the lead when sophomore midfielder **Kenzo Manners (Hamamatsu City, Japan/ Hamamatsu-Kita)** tallied 4:49 into the contest.

► Elmhurst tied the match at the 52:27 mark before thwarting a Chicago penalty kick in the 60th minute.

► Freshman goalkeeper **Chris Giusto (Davie, Fla./ Heritage)** collected seven saves.

► The win marked the first overtime victory for Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**, whose teams were 0-2-6 in extra time during the past three years.

Player Notes

► Junior midfielder **Joseph Farias-Eisner's (Calabasas, Calif./ Harvard-Westlake)** overtime goal at Elmhurst was his first career game-winner.

► Freshman netminder **Chris Giusto (Davie, Fla./ Heritage)** has started the Maroons' last six matches. He sports a 3-2-1 record with a 1.47 goals against average.

► Freshman midfielder **Stanton Coville (Powell, Ohio/ Olentangy Liberty)** leads the team with two goals in three games at Stagg Field this season. Senior forward **Edgar Friloux (Madison, Wis./ West)** and sophomore forward **Alex Clifford (Houston, Texas/ Phillips Academy Andover)** have each tallied once.

Team Notes

► Chicago needs just one more second-half goal to match its total from all of last season. The Maroons have tallied five times in the second half in seven matches this year, compared to six goals in 18 games in 2007.

► The Maroons are 8-7-4 at Stagg Field (7-6-3 grass, 1-1-1 FieldTurf) in three years under Head Coach **Scott Wiercinski**.
