# Welcome to the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual *University Athletic Association* Swimming & Diving Championships

---

The Emory University men's and women's swim teams each claimed their tenth consecutive team titles at the 2008 *University Athletic Association* Swimming and Diving Championships hosted by the University of Rochester at the Webster Aquatic Center. The Eagle women used an all-around team effort in winning their 17th overall Association championship, compiling 1,951 points for the four-day meet.

Washington University edged New York University in a battle for second place in the women's standings, compiling 1,284 points to the Violets' 1,260 points. Carnegie Mellon University finished fourth with 1,117 points, followed by the University of Chicago (852), Case Western Reserve University (791), host University of Rochester (740), and Brandeis University (588). The Emory men totaled 1,704 points in successfully defending their team championship. Carnegie Mellon and NYU finished in second (1,413) and third (1,315) place, respectively, while Washington totaled 1,142 points to finish fourth. Chicago (999), Case (677), host Rochester (634), and Brandeis (477) rounded out the standings.

The Emory tandem of freshman Liz Horvat and sophomore Ruth Westby garnered *UAA* Rookie and Swimmer of the Year accolades for the women, each capturing three individual Association titles. Horvat posted automatic-qualifying marks in winning the 500-yard and 1,650-yard freestyles, and the 400-yard individual medley, while Westby became the first *UAA* female swimmer to sweep the freestyle sprint events, establishing *UAA* meet records in the 50-yard and 100-yard freestyles to go with her crown in the 200-yard freestyle. Her times in the three longer distances were also automatic-qualifying marks. Westby also swam on two winning relays for the Eagles, anchoring the 200-yard and 400-yard freestyle relays.

NYU junior Andrew Lardiere was named the men's Swimmer of the Year after sweeping all three freestyle sprint events (the first Association male swimmer to accomplish the feat) and swimming on four victorious relays. Lardiere captured the 50-yard and 100-yard freestyles, setting Association records in both events during the preliminary heats, while adding a win in the 200-yard freestyle. He swam the anchor leg on the winning Violets' 200-yard freestyle and 200-yard medley relays, both setting new *UAA* meet records, the 400-yard medley relay, and the meet-ending 400-yard freestyle relay. Washington freshman David Chao was named the men's Rookie of the Year, registering top-ten finishes in the 50-yard (ninth), 100-yard (tied for sixth), and 200-yard (fourth) freestyles and swimming the lead-off leg of the Bears' runner-up 400-yard freestyle relay.

Washington senior Priya Srikanth and freshman Max Norris of New York garnered *UAA* men's and women's Diver of the Year accolades, respectively. Srikanth successfully defended her one-meter and three-meter springboard titles, while Norris, a Rochester-area native, made his Association championship debut by capturing both boards before the hometown crowd.

# The UAA – Where Theory Meets Practice

For 20 years, the University Athletic Association continues to serve as a bold statement of the vision of its founders — that the pursuit of academic and athletic excellence are complementary goals and can be achieved without the compromise of one by the other. The members of the UAA hold that the success of intercollegiate athletics is wholly dependent upon institutional integrity and the ability of institutions to complete the full integration of athletics into the academic fabric of higher education.

The UAA is a significant expression of the principle that the provision of a high-quality college athletic experience is worth the commitment required of an institution. It is worthwhile not only because it benefits the student-athletes, but also because it benefits the entire campus community and, in turn, the institution itself. Perhaps more importantly, the UAA is a strong statement that the success of intercollegiate athletics is wholly dependent upon institutional integrity and the ability of institutions to complete the full integration of athletics into the academic fabric of higher education.

Members of the UAA share the belief that academic excellence and athletic excellence are not mutually exclusive. Implicit in this belief are several sets of assumptions. The first is that the



academic enterprise is the primary element. Student-athletes are just that — students first and athletes second.

The second set of assumptions has to do with athletic excellence. Athletic excellence is not to be confused with a win-at-all-costs attitude. It properly relates to the caliber of experience offered to students who participate in intercollegiate athletics. Athletic teams should have the benefit of qualified coaching — capable individuals chosen for professional competence and commitment to putting the welfare of the student first. They should play and practice in first-rate facilities at reasonable times. Their equipment should be safe, of high quality, and conducive to the best performance possible. A consistent and challenging level of athletic competition should be provided to both women and men.

The final assumptions concern what might be termed a proper athletic emphasis. Athletic programs are extracurricular activities conducted for students and should be given consideration similar to that accorded other such institutionally sponsored activities. They should not only complement the academic experience, but should also reflect the quality of the academic environment within which they exist. Division III is an approach to athletics — not a synonym for third-rate.

The University Athletic Association sponsors competition in 22 sports — twelve sports for men and ten sports for women — including football, soccer, cross country, volleyball, basketball, fencing, wrestling, swimming and diving, indoor track and field, baseball, softball, outdoor track and field, tennis, and golf.

Many student-athletes from UAA institutions have been recognized for their achievements as scholars and athletes. During the 2006-07 academic year, 19 student-athletes from UAA institutions were recognized as College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-Americans, 84 received All-America honors in team or individual sports, and one garnered individual national championship accolades.

In addition, ten student-athletes from UAA institutions were among the select group of seniors across the country named NCAA Postgraduate Scholars.

Teams throughout the UAA are perennial contenders for post-season play. In 2007-08, UAA teams were selected or qualified to compete in NCAA championship competition in football, softball, and volleyball, as well as men's and women's championships in basketball, cross country, soccer, tennis, and track & field. UAA schools captured national championships in men's basketball, men's cross country, men's tennis, and volleyball, finished as national runner-up in men's tennis, and placed third in women's cross country and women's indoor track & field. In all, 18 UAA teams posted top ten finishes in their national championships, and 17 others finished in the top twenty.
