Tonight's Match

Chicago plays the first of a brief two-match homestand this evening ... Chicago seeks back-to-back victories for the second time this year ... The Maroons and Foresters have posted identical results over their last 14 matches. Both teams are 2-3 in their last five affairs after losing nine in a row ... Chicago is 1-5 at the Ratner Center, where it has dropped two straight.

Chicago vs. Lake Forest

The Maroons and Foresters meet for the 46th time since 1976 ... Lake Forest holds a 31-14 series advantage ... Chicago has won three of the last four matchups ... The Foresters defeated the Maroons 3-2 in the most recent clash a year ago in Lake Forest ... Chicago has faced Lake Forest more than any other opponent.

Kendall Nets UAA Player of the Week Honors

Senior middle hitter **Koryn Kendall (Napa, Calif./Vintage)** was named the UAA player of the week after averaging 3.73 kills per game with a .564 hitting percentage (56-3-94) at the UAA Round Robin last weekend at Case.

Kendall Sets Blocks Record, Clubs 1,000th Kill

At last week's UAA Round Robin, senior middle hitter **Koryn Kendall (Napa, Calif./Vintage)** set the Chicago career record for total blocks (365) and became the fourth player in school history to reach 1,000 career kills. Kendall, who is nine block assists shy of the school career record of 238, enters tonight's match with 1,030 lifetime kills.

Player Notes

•Sophomore outside hitter **Diandra Bucciarelli's (Del Mar, Calif./Torrey Pines)** 24 kills and 29 digs last weekend against NYU marked the first 20-20 effort by a Maroon in 2007 ... Bucciarelli has hit 20 kills twice in her last three outings and three times on the season ... Bucciarelli leads the team with 10 double-doubles (10 kills + 10 digs, aces, or blocks).

•Junior setter **Nikki Boddicker (Encino, Calif./Buckley School)** has been credited with 50 or more assists five times this season and twice in her last three matches ... Boddicker collected a career-best 58 assists against NYU.

•Junior outside hitter **Kerry Dornfeld (Cary, Ill./Cary)** has hit 10 or more kills in three of her last four matches.

•Prior to the 2005 campaign, no Chicago player had hit better than .335 in a season. Senior middle hitter **Koryn Kendall (Napa, Calif./Vintage)** changed that in 2005 when she hit .390. This season, she is hitting at a .419 clip.

•Freshman libero **Morgan Anderson (Pleasanton, Calif./Amador)** leads the Maroons with 3.55 digs per game ... Anderson collected her second 20-dig effort of the year with 20 against Rochester on Sunday.

•In her last seven matches, junior middle hitter **Katie Volzer (North Canton, Ohio/Lake)** has served 11 aces with just two errors ... Volzer leads the team with a 1.67 ace-to-error ratio.

•Sophomore outside hitter **Yayan Zhang (Chicago, Ill./University)** and freshman outside hitter **Elizabeth Kossnar (Park Ridge, Ill./Maine South)** posted career highs with 15 and 11 digs, respectively, in the Maroons' last match, a 3-0 win over Rochester on Sunday.
