



# University of Chicago (6-2) vs. Wheaton (Ill.) College (2-7)

## Game Notes

### Tonight's Match

Chicago makes its 2008 Ratner Center debut this evening ... The Maroons need just one more victory to match last year's total of seven (7-26) ... Chicago is coming off a second-place finish (three wins, one loss) at the St. Mary's (Minn.) Sugar Loaf Classic ... Wheaton brings a 2-7 mark into tonight's match ... Wheaton has won 22 of 27 previous matchups with the Maroons dating back to 1974.

### New in 2008

Beginning this season, what used to be termed, "games" are now termed, "sets." In addition, each set will be played to 25 points (teams must win by at least two), down from the 30-point standard from the past several years.

### Walby Era Begins

Head Coach **Vanessa Walby** is in her first season at the helm of the Chicago volleyball program ... Walby spent the past three seasons as assistant coach at Wisconsin-Whitewater ... During her tenure, UW-Whitewater won the NCAA Division III championship in 2005, finished second in 2007, and placed third in 2006.

### Fresh Faces

Two different freshmen have earned All-Tournament Team honors at the Maroons' first two events of the season ... At the season-opening Dominican Star Classic, freshman outside hitter **Isis Smalls (Humble, Texas/ Atascocita)** was named the MVP after leading the Maroons with 2.80 per game and a .280 hitting percentage ... Last weekend at St. Mary's, freshman outside hitter **Colleen Belak (Louisville, Ky./ Presentation Academy)** was named to the All-Tournament Team on the strength of her 4.58 kills and 3.75 kills per game.

### Player Notes

Four Maroons have hit 10 or more kills in a match this season. Freshman outside hitter **Colleen Belak (Louisville, Ky./ Presentation Academy)** leads the Maroons with four double-digit kill efforts, while senior middle blocker **Kerry Dornfeld (Cary, Ill./ Cary-Grove)** and sophomore outside hitter **Elizabeth Kossnar (Park Ridge, Ill./ Maine South)** have three to their credit. Freshman outside hitter **Isis Smalls (Humble, Texas/ Atascocita)** has collected double-digit kills on two occasions ... Freshman libero **Liane Rousseau (Cincinnati, Ohio/ Mount Notre Dame)** has collected 10 or more digs five times this season. She leads the team with 3.58 digs per game ... Dornfeld and senior middle blocker **Katie Volzer (North Canton, Ohio/ Lake)** share the team lead with 14 total blocks ... Senior setter **Nikki Boddicker (Encino, Calif./ Buckley School)** has averaged 9.74 assists per game this season. In 2007, Boddicker averaged 9.25 assists per game en route to a school record season total of 1,045.

### Team Notes

Chicago's last five victories have been three-set affairs ... Since dropping their first match of the season, the Maroons have won six of seven and have won 18 of 23 sets during that stretch ... The Maroons have won the second set in seven of their eight matches ... A win tonight would give Chicago a four-match winning streak for the first time since 2004.

### Up Next

Chicago hosts the Gargoyle Classic Friday and Saturday, Sept. 12-13. The Maroons face Denison (3 p.m.) and Trinity Christian (7 p.m.) on Friday and will meet Rockford (11 a.m.) and Lakeland (3 p.m.) on Saturday.
