#SettingTheStage

Leading the UAA race by 3 games with 5 left to play, Chicago returns home to host UAA rival Carnegie Mellon Friday at 6 pm.

#ThinkPink

Friday's game will mark the Maroons' annual Pink Zone event, dedicated to raising awareness for breast cancer research.

#LastTimeOut

Led by Morgan Herrick's 19 points, Chicago overcame a 6-point halftime deficit to win 68-55 at then No. 5 Rochester last Sunday.

#RunnerUp

Chicago has been ranked No.2 in both national polls all year. Maroons gained a 1st place vote in the D3hoops poll each of the past 2 wks.

#LuckyThirteen

With wins over Emory and Rochester on the road last week, Chicago notched its 13th straight UAA weekend sweep.

#SeriesHistory

Chicago has won its last 18 games against the Tartans to give the Maroons a 35-12 all-time series lead.

#Rematch

Chicago defeated CMU 81-44 in Pittsburgh on Jan. 13. Taylor Simpson had 14 pts/10 reb. Hannah Ballard scored 13 off the bench.

#TartansAtRatner

Chicago has won all 8 previous meetings with CMU at Ratner. Last meeting: Chicago 90-65 last year.

#SeriesScoringLeaders

Maroons' career scoring leaders vs. CMU: Hannah Ballard (13.0, 1g), Bryanne Halfhill (12.1, 7g), Morgan Herrick (10.7, 3g).

#Undefeated

As of Feb. 5, Chicago was 1 of 4 undefeated teams left in NCAA D3. Others: Amherst, George Fox, Mary Washington.

#38Special

Chicago has won 38 consecutive regular season games, marking the longest current regular season winning streak in NCAA D3.

#Chicago60637

The Maroons sport a 22-game winning streak at the Ratner Center, where they are 11-0 this season.

#PackLeaders

Chicago has won 23 consecutive UAA contests and is 29-1 in league play since Feb. 5, 2010.

#DownButNotOut

Chicago has overcome halftime deficits in 3 of its 9 UAA wins, 5 of 20 overall.

#HalfwayThere

When leading at halftime, Chicago has won 48 in a row and 88 of its last 90 (15-0 in 2011-12).

#OnTarget

Chicago leads the UAA, ranks 10th nationally with a .446 FG percentage. Maroons have outshot their opponents in 19 of 20 games.

#OffTarget

The Maroons' .332 opponent FG% is the best in the UAA. Chicago has held opponents below 30% in 7 of 20 games.

#WideMargin

Chicago's +18.2 scoring margin leads the UAA and ranks 14th in NCAA D3. Maroons have won 16 of 20 by double digits.

#LeadingTheLeague

Chicago has 3 UAA stat leaders: Morgan Herrick (.585 FG%), Joann Torres (.464 3FG%), and Bryanne Halfhill (2.0 AST/TO ratio).

#Under60

The Maroons have held their opponents to fewer than 60 points in 9 straight games and 11 of 12.

#TeamOfTheWeek

Morgan Herrick was named to the D3hoops.com Team of the Week after averaging 18.0 pts, 6.0 reb w/70.8 FG% in 2 UAA wins last week.

#ConferenceCall

Morgan Herrick is the Maroons' leading scorer in UAA play (12.9 ppg). She has scored double figures in 7 of 9 league games.

#OnTheLine

Starters are shooting a combined 81.4% from the FT line in UAA play. Leaders: Joann Torres (92.9%, 13-14), Morgan Herrick (87.5%, 14-16).

#DoubleDigits

Taylor Simpson leads the team with 15 double-digit scoring efforts this year. She has scored 10+ in 2 straight, 9 of 10, 13 of 15.

#PerfectAttendance

Meghan Herrick played in her 100th consecutive game as a Maroon last Sunday at Rochester.

#SecondChances

Nearly half of Taylor Simpson's team-high 169 rebounds (44%) have been offensive. She has had 3+ off. reb. in all 9 UAA games to date.

#SiblingRivalry

Chicago is 20-1 over the past 2 years when Meghan Herrick and older sister Morgan score double digits in the same game.

#BallControl

Bryanne Halfhill sports a nearly 3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio (31-11) in UAA play.
